

Privacy statement DIS is me

We have the highest regard for the privacy of interested parties and we handle any personal data you provide us with, such as your name, organization and e-mail address, with utmost care. In this privacy statement we give insight into how we put the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) into practice.

Person in charge of personal data

DIS is me is a platform and not a company, foundation or association. That is why we are not registered with the Chamber of Commerce. The person responsible for the management of the website, and the collection, storage and processing of personal data is Anne Lagemaat, who can be reached via anne.lagemaat@dis-is-me.nl.

Use of personal data

We only use the personal data that you provide *DIS is me* with for the purpose for which you give permission. For example, to send the updates about *DIS is me*, or to answer your message.

Processing of personal data

Access to personal data provided to *DIS is me* is limited to persons for whom this is necessary for the work they perform for *DIS is me*.

Storage period of personal data

We do not keep your data longer than necessary to do what you have given us permission to do. For example, as long as *DIS is me* exists and develops activities, if you have subscribed to the updates about *DIS is me*.

Viewing, changing or deleting personal data

You can inform us at any time that you want to view, change or if you want us to delete your data. This can be done by sending an email with your request to info@dis-is-me.nl. We will then process your request as soon as possible.

Storage and processing of personal data

For the website, newsletters and online collaboration, *DIS is me* uses the services of third parties, with whom we conclude or have concluded a processing agreement if applicable. This stipulates, among other things, that personal data is sent and stored encrypted at all times in accordance with the AVG guidelines. The servers of these third parties are only located in the Netherlands and Europe.
